### Results:

#### European Directive 84/500/EEC and its amendment 2005/31/EC – Leachable Lead and Cadmium & BS 6748:1986+ A1:2011

**Method:** The amount of Lead/Cadmium in the total quantity of extracting solution is expressed as milligrams of Pb and Cd per litre or per square decimetre of surface area.

Extracting solution: 4% v/v acetic acid for 24 hrs at 22°C +/- 2°C.
